
NO EFFING. JUST BLINDING!




Did you know that most windows are a little bit wonky along the top? This makes the hanging of a blind so it looks straight on a window, quite a difficult thing to achieve.

The Bloc Guide Dog is the perfect solution. This fully patented, simple device allows you to put a blind up without having to drill into your wall and it's easy to use adjustment teeth allow you to reposition by 6mm on either side to enable your blind to hang straight.



Factory Setting




Remove Adjustable Piece



Adjustment of 3 mm is now set



With the Bloc EasyFit Range, putting up a blind is now as easy as ABC:

Adhere the Bloc Guide Dogs to the wall by lining them up as shown, peeling off the backing paper and sticking them to the clean, dry surface of the wall. Secure them to the wall using the nails provided.

the blind cassette into the Guide Dog and click it into place.

Change the levelling of the blind cassette (if you need to), using the teeth on the Bloc Guide Dogs and once correct according to your window, screw it into place using the attached screws.
